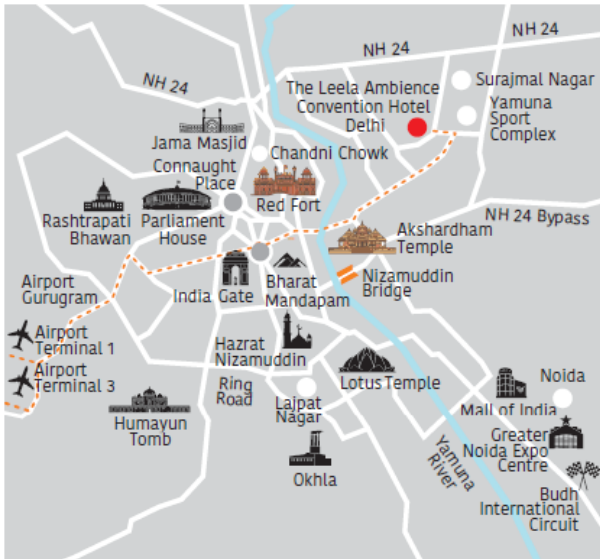

2.1 Arrival by Air



NEW DELHI (DEL) Indira Gandhi International Airport

Indira Gandhi International Airport (DEL) is India's largest and busiest airport and one of the world's leading aviation hubs. During the 2024–2025 financial year, the airport handled more than 79 million passengers, including over 21 million international travelers. It is currently ranked among the world's ten busiest airports.

Located approximately 16 km from central New Delhi, the airport offers modern facilities, efficient passenger processing and direct international connections across five continents. Terminal 3, used for most international flights, is recognized as one of Asia's most advanced airport terminals.

TRAVEL TIPS:

- Arrive at the airport at least 3 hours before international departures.
- International check-in counters generally close 75 minutes before departure.
- Security screening is generally efficient, but waiting times may increase during peak morning and evening hours.

- Keep your passport, visa and boarding pass readily available for multiple document checks.
- Power banks are permitted only in cabin baggage.
- Free Wi-Fi is available throughout the airport.
- Currency exchange, ATMs, lounges, restaurants and duty-free shopping are available 24/7.

2.2 Airport Transfers

Airport Transfer service will be available from/to **NEW DELHI (DEL) Indira Gandhi International Airport** at the price of 40 € / person / round trip (60 € / person / round trip if booked after 26th of September).

Welcome Service will be provided upon arrival at NEW DELHI (DEL) Indira Gandhi International Airport based on the bookings.

The teams will be met by their welcome team and volunteers with welcome board containing logo of the championships.

Operating hours are from **Monday 26th of October to Saturday 7th of November 2026 from 7:00 to 22:00**. If booked in time transfers outside the operating hours are possible upon availability and confirmation at no extra cost.

After collecting luggage, team members will be escorted to the official transfers by the welcome desk staff and taken to the official hotels.

The transfer time from the airport to the official hotels and return is approximately **45 to 90 minutes**.

Returning transfers must be re-confirmed at least 2 days before departure.

Please book your transfer at pafiworld@gmail.com **before 26th of September 2026**.

For transfers booked after **26th of September 2026** and/or outside of operating days/hours if not booked and confirmed before, the price is 60 € per person round-trip.

The Organizer cannot be held responsible for transfers not booked within the time limits.



VISA REQUIRED

Most foreign nationals require a valid visa or e-Visa to enter India. Participants are advised to check the latest requirements applicable to their nationality.

All National Federations athletes and officials (including referees) will require an entry sport visa and they are kindly requested to send the delegation details (name and surname, status/role, nationality, date of birth, passport number, passport expiry date) together with a clear copy of each passport to:

Official invitation letters will be issued within 3 working days after receiving the required documents.

3. HOTELS / ACCOMMODATION / VENUE

3.1 General Information

All reservations will be made only by email at pafiworld@gmail.com no later than **26th of September 2026**. Phone calls are accepted only within working hours.

The hotels will officially open with full service on **26th of October 2026**. If members of your federation are planning to arrive earlier, please contact the Organizer in advance to make sure specific arrangements are made.

All national teams must be accommodated only in the official hotels appointed by the Organizer and reservations will be made only with the organizing committee, otherwise the competitors will not have the right to compete in the championships (WAF Approved Rule).

The Organizing Committee will provide the hotel that best meets team's needs. Reservations will be subject to availability and the payments received and will dispatch rooms according to the number of participants of each team and the needs of accessibility.

Athletes who are not accommodated in the official hotels will be required to pay a service fee of 250 €/athlete, representing the services provided to all participants during the event. Failure to pay this fee will result in the disqualification of the athlete or, in some cases, the entire team.

The payments will be made by bank transfer in advance, by credit card or with cash before checking in. Teams must pay for all services before check-in, partial check-in is not available.

Reservations not confirmed or not paid will be automatically cancelled within 7 days from the invoice date.

The teams must send their hotel reservation form and payments latest **26th of September 2026**, after this date the hotel prices may grow to 25 %.

Free accommodation and airport transfers offered by the Organizer to the WAF Officials (nominated referees and WAF Officials, technical) must be confirmed at the latest **26th of September 2026**, If no arrangements have been made, after this date the Organizer will not be responsible for the accommodation or airport transfers.

Nominated referees will be accommodated in shared double rooms in a 4-star hotel. Here they will receive Full board food service (breakfast, lunch, dinner). They may accommodate in other hotels if the arrangements are made before **26th of September 2026**. When ordering accommodation for the nominated referees, please specify in the booking form that the person is a nominated referee, the invoice must contain the discount for his/her share of the room. The nominated referees check-in day is **27th of October and check-out is 7th of October 2026 (11 nights)**.

The minimum stay period for athletes and team officials is **three (3) nights**, check-in on the day before the official weigh-in and check-out on the day following the athlete's last competition day.

Team accommodation will be settled before check-in at the Leela Ambience Convention Hotel Help Desk. Here teams will pay other services ordered.

Teams arriving from the airport will wait at their hotels until check-in formalities are fulfilled with the Organizer by their team captains.

Check-in time is 14:00 and check-out time is 12:00. Early check-in or late check-out must be confirmed with the Organizer. Extra costs may be requested by Hotels.

A deposit for the minibar (if available) may be requested by the Hotels reception. Minibar is not included in the accommodation package.

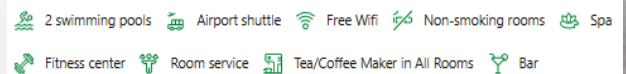

4.1 Team Registration

TEAMS NOT REGISTERED ONLINE WILL PAY A PROCESSING FEE OF 250 € AT LOCATION.

The online registration will open on 26th of August and will be closed on 14th of October 2026.

Team Registration at the Championship will take place in the Leela Ambience Convention Hotel, on Tuesday, 27th of October 2026, between 10⁰⁰-14⁰⁰ according to the country schedule, which will be published one week before.

WEIGH-IN PROCEDURE FOR THE TEAM CAPTAINS

- ❖ Team Captain must be present with the Team during weigh-in procedure to answer any questions.
- ❖ Each team captain will prepare the team for the weigh-in in the following order:
Ladies 50, 55, 60 kg and continue... Men 55, 60, 65 kg and continue...
Please note:
- ❖ If a competitor does not make weight, they have time until 15⁰⁰ to come back for the second weigh-in.
- ❖ A test scale will be available for near weigh-in rooms.
- ❖ A competitor has the right to go at the official weigh-in scales only two times. A competitor may only do the second weigh-in between other countries weigh-in.
- ❖ A competitor may weigh-in to their normal weight or register one weight class higher.
- ❖ The Team Captain will wait until all the team athletes will be registered and pictures taken. Once the full Team is completed,
- ❖ Once the competitor has weighed-in, they will have a picture taken for their Official Competitor Badge. Team captain will pick-up the official competitor badges at the end of the weigh-in day from the [Help Desk](#) at the place where weigh-in was done.
- ❖ The Team Captain must check all the data included in the badge and notify immediately if any errors are found. Please check categories codes, arms, country flag, athlete name.
- ❖ **Junior & Master Athletes who want to compete in Senior classes must do the second weigh-in together with the Seniors, they can do priority weigh-in (between teams) only with the competition badge.**

WEIGH-IN PROCEDURE FOR ATHLETES

1. Each athlete must provide to the WAF weigh-in officers:
 - a. Photocopy and original of the identity document (Passport, Photo ID)
 - b. Weigh-in ticket received by the Team Captain at the Team Registration.
 - c. GDPR signed declaration (if provided).
2. If necessary, the athlete can undress before step onto the official scale.
3. The athlete weigh-in will be noted into the country weigh-in official WAF form.
4. If the athlete did not manage to make the weight for the needed category, he has the right to do a second weigh-in until 15⁰⁰. Only two official weigh-ins are allowed.
5. If an athlete managed to do the weight for the desired category, after having his weight registered in the WAF forms, he must go to the free weigh-in officer to take a photo.
6. After finishing the procedure, the competitor must leave the Weigh-in room.
7. Athlete takes his/her official competitor badge from his/her Team Captain.

4.4 Classification Procedures

CLASSIFICATION

The **Classification** will be held on

Friday 30th of October 2026, from 10⁰⁰ at the Leela Ambience Convention Hotel.

All para athletes who must be classified must arrive on time for the classification session according with the country schedule.

Classification will only be held for registered participants of the championship.

For athletes requiring classification, a Medical Intake Form translated into English is mandatory and must be submitted to the Chief Classifier by 14th of September 2026 at classification@waf-armwrestling.com . All required forms can be found [here](#).

Failure to submit the required documentation by the deadline will result in a fine of 250 € per athlete, and classification prior to competition cannot be guaranteed and therefore the Athlete will not be eligible to participate in the Championship.

There will be only 1 panel of VI classifier. In case of protests, it will not be possible to have a new classification in place. It could be done on another event with a VI classification session.

CLASSIFICATION SEMINAR

The **Classification training seminar** will be held on **Thursday 29th of October 2026 starting at 14⁰⁰ at Leela Ambience Convention Hotel** only for the registered participants.

Training, testing and certification.

The course is open to any interested person with a medical or physiotherapist / sports Science background who wish to become classifier.

To take part, participants must register to the course latest **by 14th of October 2026** at classification@waf-armwrestling.com and ask for confirmation.

Trainee classifiers who wish to complete their International Classifiers training will be required to attend other WAF competitions.

Coaches and other trainers who are interested in classification may attend for information and education purposes.

OPENING CEREMONIES

The Official Opening Ceremony is scheduled for **Thursday 29th of October 2026, at 16:00.**

Two members from each country wearing the official team dress **are requested to be present at the venue on Thursday 29th of October 2026, at 15:30.** They will hold their country sign and they may bring their own flag.

The Opening Ceremony will feature:

- ❖ Artistic show linked to local culture.
- ❖ Video and media content presenting the event.
- ❖ Opening speeches / protocol.
- ❖ A parade of all participating national teams.
- ❖ Presentation of the event referees.

CLOSING CEREMONY

The Organizer will conduct a Closing Ceremony on **Friday 6th of November 2026, at 21:00.** Additional information will be provided at the time of competition.

All participants can attend.

AWARDING CEREMONIES

The Awarding Ceremonies will take place after the final match of each category. The third place must be ready for awarding. **No flags are allowed on the podium during awarding ceremony.**

Medallists must wear official team dress on the podium. No other team member is accepted on the stage during the awarding ceremonies. Medallists must have prepared the Passport / ID for the doping testing.

Medallists will receive medal and certificate from VIP's and officials.

Athletes shall be placed on the podium according to the following order (2, 1, 3).

Each athlete who has won a medal must be present at the ceremony and receive the medal personally. It could be considered inappropriate for athletes on the podium to have items other than the official flag and fixed on their uniform. Religious, political, personal, or commercial connotation or wearing a cap or any similar covers on the head is not permitted.

All working staff (administration, scoring, technical, referees, sound, lights, video, antidoping, classification, medical care, security etc.) are exempted to follow the Anthem protocol during awarding, opening, and any ceremonies where national anthem is played. However, during the playing of the national anthems all working staff are required to work in silence where it is possible.

4.6 Anti-Doping Procedures

DOPING CONTROL

Antidoping Control will take place after each category podium ceremony. After the ceremony, all medalists must go to the anti-doping committee desk near the stage for random or targeted testing. They must have prepared the Passport or the National ID.

The World Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the WADA Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the championships.

Random and/or targeted Anti-doping tests will be conducted In Competition. WAF and/or WADA may carry out random and/or targeted out-of-competition testing prior, during or after the championships.

TUE (THERAPEUTIC USE EXEMPTION)

Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the “Prohibited List” of the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to visit WAF website <http://www.waf-armwrestling.com/anti-doping/forbiden-substances/>.
